Access a wealth of modern topics in physics, mathematics and more. Relatives and friends of a man who died after being stabbed by a stranger on a train said he has been left without his future. Twenty-five-year-old Peter Maloney died on Sunday at a hospital in Dewsbury, West Yorkshire. Friends of the father-of-one, from Wath Brow, Huddersfield, spoke of their devastation after the attack and vowed to get justice for him. "We are absolutely devastated. He was a lovely lad who had a big heart. I think for him it was a case of coming home from work and seeing things he wasn't expecting," Maria Delfino, 22, from Barnsley, South Yorkshire, said. "We would get the train and he would always come home and say 'I've just had a nice day at work.' He would come home and tell us about his day." Delfino said Maloney's partner works in Huddersfield and was asked to look after their daughter and two-year-old son. "She was doing a two-day course so she left early on the morning of the incident," she added. "Peter was the one who was meant to be there. She knew she was gone at 8am and when she got home at 7.45pm he was already dead." Lakshmi Prasad, 23, from Huddersfield, said: "He'd been on the train a couple of times and the police had come and spoken to him about what he was doing in the train. "He seemed fine on both occasions. When he died he'd never done anything like this before." Witnesses heard shouting and a scuffle before a man was seen walking from the train and, a few minutes later, leaving the station. Police were called and a man was arrested at the scene. He is in custody and has been charged with murder. Chris Sallon, 24, from Huddersfield, was one of those who was in the busy platform waiting to get off a train in Dewsbury when 82157476af
